

WORKSHEET – POLENET living and working in the cold

1) Choose a form of polar transport (could be land, sea or air). Draw a sketch and label the parts of the vehicle. Explain the special adaptations to cold climate work.

2) Animals are the experts at adapting to polar conditions. Give some examples or how they live and how they are adapted to life in the cold.

3) Choose a polar research station. Where is it and what kinds of things are studied there?

4) Imagine you're a glaciologist working on a field project. Write diary entries for 1 week including general living, working, delays for bad weather and a social event (invent a good reason for a party in a field tent).
